KATHRYN MOSTOW AT THE JAZZ GALLERY

Seattle artist Kathryn Mostow will be making her New York debut at the Jazz Gallery on **Tuesday, Nov. 25th at 8 PM.** Mostow has been garnering the attention of critics and folk enthusiasts alike with her stunning voice and intimate songwriting.

Kathryn spent over 20 years studying classical voice and performing in a number of choral groups and pop/jazz a cappella ensembles. But it wasn't until 1998 that Kathryn picked up the guitar and began to write songs of her own. Buoyed by the positive response from the Seattle folk community, Kathryn continued to write and play and by March 2000 had begun performing professionally. She has since performed to excited audiences at a variety of festivals and venues up and down the West Coast. This will be her first New York appearance.

RECORDING

Kathryn's debut CD, **Gratitude** was chosen as a **Top 12 Do-It-Yourself album** by *Performing Songwriter* magazine, and has charted at radio stations across the country. Her second CD, **Dreamers Everywhere** (released May 2005) reflects Kathryn's growing maturity as a player, performer and songwriter. Its 10 songs weave Latin, blues, folk and a capella traditions into a decidedly more roots-based and acoustic album.
